DESTINATION VALENCIA

Valencia was founded in the year 138 BC by the Romans, who built a forum in the area now occupied by Plaza de la Almoina. Underneath the plaza there is a museum where you can see the Roman remains. The Romans were followed by the Visigoths, and in the year 714 the city fell to the Moors. Valencia remained under Moorish rule until 1238, when King Jaime I expelled the Moors from the city. The Moors had a significant impact on the region, and brought with them new irrigation methods, cuisine, and artistic influences that are still felt today.
